



**Vassilios Kondylis** is Professor at the Department of Public Law of the Law School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens [NKUA]. From October 1980 to May 1985 he studied at the Law Department of the NKUA Law School of Athens. From October 1985 until July 1986 he obtained Master (DEA) in Public Law, University of Paris I, Pantheon-Sorbonne. From November 1986 to April 1991 followed doctoral studies in Public Law at the University Paris I and received a relevant PhD.

Since May 1988 he is a lawyer, member of the Athens Bar Association. Since November 2000, he is a Supreme Court lawyer.

From March 20, 1995 until October 6, 2000 he worked in Luxembourg as Referendary (Legal Secretary) at the European Court of justice, to the Office of the Advocate General Mr. G. Kosmas. From January 1, 2004 he is the Legal Counsel of the Hellenic Telecommunications and Post Commission (EETT). On 09.02.2009 he was appointed as Lecturer in the Law School of NKUA (Department of Public Law - Sector of Public Law). From 01.10.2018 he was Associate Professor and from 01.01.2022 a Full Professor of the Law School of NKUA. From 01.02.2012 he is a member of the Greek Atomic Energy Commission (EEAE) Board. From 01.01.2015 he was a member of the OECD European Court of Atomic Energy [European Nuclear Energy Tribunal], on a five -year term.

He has published a Treaty of Administrative Law with Honorary Professor Ep. Spiliotopoulos, several monographs and more than 60 articles, chronicles, comments, book reviews, etc., in various legal journals or collective volumes in Greece and abroad.
